TASTING NOTES A deep red coloured wine with violet hues, suggestive of good and slow evolution. Rich with good intensity characterised by floral and forest fruit aromas and a hint of balsamic and dark chocolate. Good volume on palate, well-structured but smooth tannins, well-matched with quality fruit leading to a long and elegant finish (tasted on 28 May 2019).

NOTES Store the bottle horizontally. Serve between 16 and 18°C.
